October 1st is the first day of the heating season and Lyon-Lincoln Electric would like to remind everyone with an electric heat meter to make sure that the breaker is on. If the breaker is off, the electric heat meter will not measure the energy used to heat your home and you will miss out on the lower electric heat rate. Heating season is just around the corner. If you have a heat meter, you can start getting heat credit with your October reading. Be sure the breaker to the heat meter is on. We encourage you to leave these breakers on year-round. Without power, the automatic meter reading can't detect trouble or report readings.
